The 474-room Naples Grande Beach Resort in Florida will reopen on Friday, Dec. 15, following a three-and-a-half-month closure to repair damage caused by Hurricane Irma. The property has undergone a multimillion-dollar refresh of its guest rooms, public spaces, pools and outdoor landscaping, as well as several meeting spaces, including the Vista Ballroom. Additional amenities restored include the resort's restaurants and spa.
